

True Believers are Servants

Discerning between righteousness and wickedness.

If Yahuweh does not speak to His people, then how can He possibly fulfill this promise? **“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:”** (Joel 2: 28). Wasn't Yah serious when he said?: **“Surely the Sovereign Yahuweh will do nothing, but he revealeth His secret unto His servants the prophets.”** (Amos 3: 7) Our Creator speaks to His people, then and now.

As long as people try to find truth in religion they will continue to walk in darkness. They will try different religions, sects and cults in the hope that they will come to the knowledge of the truth. But they will ultimately fail.

How can that be true? Considering that people, around the world in every culture, have no knowledge of Yahuweh (El) and His son Yahushua. Our Creator has turned His back on them and left them to their own devices and imaginations. Therefore, the masses stumble around a though they are drunk. They cannot hear, nor do they see.

The entire world has been fed with lies, falsehood, corrupt religions, politics, and false hope. The world has been deceived by spirits they cannot see, and by tricks of demons that they do not know.

However, in spite of such great trouble, there are a few who are not attached to the way of the world. These have not worshiped and bowed down to false mighty ones that have no life. These are true servants of Yahuweh. According to the prophet Malachi, these are Yah's jewels that do what few people do; **[they think on His Name and serve Him:](#)**

“Then they that feared spake often one to another: and Yahuweh hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared Yahuweh, and [that thought upon His Name.](#) And [they shall be mine,](#) saith Yahuweh of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. Then shall ye return, and [discern between the righteous and the wicked,](#) between him that serveth Elohim and him that serveth him not.” (Mal. 3:16-18).

These jewels in Yahuweh's treasury are set apart from the masses that stumble in darkness, for they are active in His service and call with His Name in their meditation and prayers. **[Therefore my people shall know My Name:](#)** (Isa. 52:6). **[Let thy work appear unto thy servants,](#)** (Ps. 90:16).

Finding Your Niche in Yah's Service

Can you find your place in serving Yahuweh? Oh yes you can, and you can know it with certainty. Read King David's ninetieth Psalm especially verses 12 through 17. David asked for Yah's wisdom during his daily meditation. **"My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart shall be of understanding."** (Ps. 49:3).

David asked for and received his instructions directly from Yahuweh, whom he addressed with His Name: **"Give ear to my words, O Yahuweh, consider my meditation."** (Ps. 5:1)

Everyone has a connection with our Creator, but very few know how to use it. Most do not even know His Name, let alone how to use it in addressing the Almighty One. However, you can call Him with His Name and ask Him for understanding and the wisdom to use it in His service. You will be amazed at the positive response.

You can experience the same great joy that David received from his meditative prayer: **"I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation."** (Ps. 119:99). Can you feel David's joy? He was getting his instructions directly from Yahuweh.

The Bricks and Mortar of Meditative Prayer

"Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." (Mk. 11:24).

The Master Teacher of Righteousness has taken a gift from His treasury for you and me. Along with the gift, He has given us instructions for opening it, so we may access its content. The gift is prayer in the proper manner, "In faith believing."

When Adam and Eve were the entire race, the Almighty walked and talked with them. But ever since sin dulled human ears to hearing and human eyes to seeing Yah, He has not been able to communicate with everyone individually. The race as a whole does not desire His fellowship and are not sensitive enough to hear His voice.

If Yah's messengers are to present His message, "In faith believing" is the means of our desires being fulfilled in Yah's service, but first one must establish a personal connection with our Creator. The Master Teacher gives us the way:

"Thou shalt love Yahuweh thy Elohim with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind." (Mt. 22:37).

Love is Yah's Law of Attraction. If you love Him, you will get His attention. There is no substitute for loving our Creator. Let me illustrate that with a common, every day, experience.

When you say the words "I love you" to someone in your family, or a special friend, it bonds you to that person in an intimate relationship. You may say "thank you" to a total stranger, but you would never say to that person "I love you"; for it would be inappropriate.

Think about that! You may be grateful to Yah for His gift of salvation through Yahushua Messiah, but it is not necessarily an expression of your love for Him. Consider how you feel in your relationship with someone when he or she praises you for your character. When someone says to you: "You are so kind" or, "you are amazing", "you are so creative". Those expressions are bonding words in your relationship to that person. Now, apply that principal to your relation to Yah. An expression of love is how David bonded to Yah. **"I will love thee, O Yahuweh, my strength."** (Ps. 18:1).

In your prayer, "In Faith Believing", acknowledge Yahuweh for who He is, as did David: **"I will extol thee, my Elohim, O King; and I will bless Thy Name for ever and ever."** (Ps. 145:1). Praise reflects our love to Yah and cements our relationship to Him in bonding intimacy.

With that kind of contact, you will establish your niche in the service of our Creator. Like David: **"I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation."** (Ps. 119:99)..

Application of Your Niche

A Spanish proverb says, **"Every hair makes its shadow on the ground"**. Everyone who has ever lived on planet earth has influenced others in some way. For good or bad, we each cast a shadow of influence to those around us, and a witness to them of the things we have experienced.

As Kingdom values flow to one called into Yahuweh's service, the Father's truth is absorbed, first as knowledge and understanding, then as wisdom, when application is made. Influence on others whom the Father is calling begins to outflow from a son or daughter of the Kingdom.

Collectively, these become traveling companions, assisting each other in the faith and offering encouragement to weaker ones, but individually, each one of us casts a shadow of influence to a world that has been fed with lies, falsehood, corrupt religions, politics, and false hope.

Practical application of your niche in Yah's service is assisted by Paul's advice to Timothy:

"And the servant of Yahuweh must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if Yahuweh peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will." (2 Tim. 2:24-26).
